

Constitution of the Competition for the Ensuing Season

UNDER 11.

Currently **30 teams** are entered.

As per the last few seasons, I propose a pre-Christmas friendly competition, (divisions to be based on the Under 10 Divisional Results & location) & to include cup fixtures.

The competitive element to start at Xmas to the end of the season.

Five divisions pre Christmas plus inter divisional games to assess ability (where necessary)

Fixtures will be set for the first two playing week-ends of September unless managers tell me otherwise (due to 11+ exams *KENT SCHOOLS*). **Start - Sat 11th September**

The cup competition will be a full open draw based on the number of **Cup entry forms** received.

The post-Christmas competition will also allow new entries from Mini-Soccer. Whether friendly or competitive, to be decided on application.

UNDER 12.

Currently **31 Teams** are entered. I propose to run three divisions with a 30/40/40 split, 9/11/11. Should these numbers reduce, the divisions would be altered to balance out the teams, with the A division being the smallest.

The cup competition will be a full open draw based on the number of **Cup entry forms** received.

UNDER 13

There are currently **24 teams** entered in this age group. I propose to run THREE divisions of 8 / 8 / 8. Dependant on late entries / drop outs. If any teams drop out the divisions would be restructured with the A division being a smaller division with a 30/40/40 split.

Based on last Seasons performances, I have balanced out the divisions as best possible, to facilitate the new teams.

The cup competition will be a full open draw based on the number of **Cup entry forms** received.

UNDER 14

There are currently **13 teams** entered in this age group. I propose to run one division.

All teams will play each other once pre Christmas, and adopt the Scottish structure post Christmas, Top teams will play each other twice, Bottom teams play each other twice .

This will stop the weaker teams being overwhelmed twice by the top clubs and should make both halves of the post Christmas competition, competitive.

Dependant on late entries. Should we receive a late entry. I would split into two divisions of seven playing each other 3 times. A drop out will revert to the normal TWO fixture regime.

The cup competition will be a full open draw based on the number of **Cup entry forms** received.

UNDER 15

There are currently **26 teams** entered in this age group. I propose to run THREE divisions of 8/9/9. Dependant on late entries / drop outs. If any teams drop out the divisions would be restructured with the B division being a larger division with a 40/60 split. All three divisions will play three fixtures, to be reviewed during the season should the weather interfere with these arrangements.

The cup competition will be a full open draw based on the number of **Cup entry forms** received.

UNDER 16.

There are currently **16 teams** entered in this age group. I propose to run TWO divisions of 8 / 8 dependant on late entries / drop outs. Both divisions will play three fixtures, to be reviewed during the season should the weather interfere with these arrangements

The cup competition will be a full open draw based on the number of **Cup entry forms** received.

UNDER 18.

Currently **12 teams** are entered.

I propose 1 division of **12 teams**. **Which may entail some mid-week fixtures?**

All teams will play each other twice in a normal format division. Mid-week fixtures will be allocated to alleviate the possibility of a back-log, come the end of the Season

The cup competition will be a full open draw based on the number of **Cup entry forms** received.

The Competitions Committee met on Thur 22nd July to finalize and ratify the Divisions.

Proposed leagues were posted on the web-site on Sunday 25th July.

Fixtures will be produced and posted by the 22nd August. (Withdrawals after this date will be fined)

Deadline for Cup Entry forms is the 31st August

~~Should you think you have been put in the wrong division, only genuine substantiated requests will be considered. Any move is not guaranteed & may well incur a suspended points penalty. The competitions committee have deliberated on all the relevant information received from clubs and decisions were made on these facts and league standings from last season.~~

Proposed Girls Competition Season 2009-10 format

The cup competition will be drawn post Christmas which will allow any new teams to enter the competition having completed the relevant, **Cup entry forms.**
